DREDGING AND OTHER WATERWAYS CONCERNS

At a recent meeting of the Port Mandurah Canals Waterways Advisory Group, it was confirmed that a tender had been approved by Council and a dredge license issued. CGC Dredging has been awarded the contract, and a start date will be influenced by mobilisation and maintenance requirements subsequent to its current dredging commitments at Kalbarri. The City of Mandurah is hopeful that work will commence prior to Christmas. The scope of the project is to clean out the Northern Entrance to the main canal and an area across the Fairbridge Bank.

In addition to the above, a \$20,000 budget has been allocated to undertake a feasibility study into sand movement and the construction of a rock groyne at the Northern Entrance of the main canal from Henry Sutton Grove Park. The object of this exercise is to test the hypothesis that a groyne will prevent the silting up of the Northern Entrance.

ATTENTION RECREATIONAL BOAT OWNERS

The Department of Transport is inviting submissions for funding of boating facilities:

The Recreational Boating Facilities Scheme (RBFS) is paid for out of the boat licensing fees that we all pay. Submissions need to be agreed by the City of Mandurah before they can be submitted to the DoT as the City would have to pay at least 25% of the cost of a proposed facility. However, that should not be considered a deterrent as we are confident that the City would consider any suggestion on its merits.

Please let us know of any facility that you think could reasonably be proposed for consideration under the RBFS. The facilities approved last year included jetties, fenders, eco toilets, trailer bays, launching ramps and engineering for such facilities.
