We took photos of the rubbish collected adjacent to some building sites and sent them to the local newspapers which resulted in publication of a couple of articles. We also sent the photos and a submission to the Council and to Cr. Gary Brown, who has instigated a 'zero tolerance' policy re messy building sites. Hopefully, we will soon see the results of this new policy. We will be keeping the pressure on!!

BIG BOATS IN CANALS

You may have had a chuckle reading Michael Weir's 'HOTT' column in 'The West' (19/3) commenting on a Port Mandurah resident who is complaining about the large size of some boats in the Port Mandurah Canals. Weir's final comment is that "it's just plain stupid"!

Our biggest concern is over the instability of the Fairbridge Bank, caused, in part by the sand by-pass activities at the mouth of the Estuary, and the potential that this has to make the requirement for regular dredging an incalculable financial nightmare. The issue is not about access for BIG boats; the Northern canal entrance could soon be inaccessible to ALL boats! We must have a long-term solution and the only way we will get this is by continuing to work amicably and constructively with the Council and DPI.
